The landscape of advanced prostate cancer is evolving rapidly and becoming increasingly complex. It can sometimes feel like it's difficult to keep up to date. In this masterclass we will give you advice and tips on how to investigate and manage advanced prostate cancer. This workshop will be a very practical "how to" session for Urologists covering important and relevant topics such as the role of treating the prostate in metastatic disease, the role of PSMA PET CT, and how to prescribe and monitor the new antiandrogens in hormone sensitive and castration resistant prostate cancer. It will also cover some of the emerging therapies such as theranostics, and potentially new systemic treatments such as immunotherapy & PARP inhibitors. This session will equip you with the skills and confidence to treat and monitor these patients, as well as how to manage the side effects of treatments caused by first and second line ADT. The masterclass will also address the effects on mental health and the very important issues of sexual dysfunction in men with advanced disease and their partners.
